TEMPER'S CUP | 26

REFRESHING • FRUITY • HERBACEOUS

Our signature in a glass — ripe strawberry, cool cucumber, and tropical kiwi laced with Hendrick's Grand Cabaret gin. Joyously fizzy with a touch of sparkling wine.

THE BIG APPLE | 26

SWEET & SOUR • SPICED • REFRESHING

New York swagger meets Duxton heat. Woodford Reserve rye whiskey and Jack Apple are shaken with cinnamon, lemon, crowned with a scoop of house-made sangria granita.



T.T.K OLD FASHIONED | 26

NUTTY • VELVETY • BOLD

Monkey Shoulder whisky, washed with peanut butter, deepens into toasted sesame and cacao bitters, wrapped in a curl of coconut smoke. Smooth, spirit-forward, and savoury — a love letter to our beloved local snack: tutu kueh.





STAR FRUIT MARTINI | 27

SAVOURY • BRINY • REFRESHING

The taste of Southeast Asia under moody lights. Hendrick's gin and dry vermouth pair with the tang of star fruit.



DUXTON ARTS & CULTURE COLLECTION

Pours that trace the Duxton neighbourhood's journey
from nutmeg plantation to modern day
— a taste of the art, culture, and spirit of its past and present.

1800s – 1900s: NUTMEG PLANTATION AND EARLY DUXTON HILL

Duxton Hill was originally part of a 13-hectare nutmeg plantation owned by Dr. J. William Montgomery. Nutmeg was a highly prized spice and major economic driver in early colonial Singapore. The land was later auctioned off and developed for residential and commercial purposes.





NUTMEG PIÑA COLADA | 26

RICH • SWEET • SPICED • FRUITY

Spiced Hennessy V.S.O.P. and Drambuie blended with mango, passionfruit, and a coconut milk wash. A nod to the nutmeg plantations that once ruled these hills.

1860s – 1940s: OPIUM DENS & SHOPHOUSE BUSTLE

As Chinese immigrants settled in Singapore, Duxton grew into a crowded, working-class hub. Opium dens became prevalent in the area and in nearby Chinatown — heavily taxed and regulated, yet central to colonial Singapore's economy and vice trade.





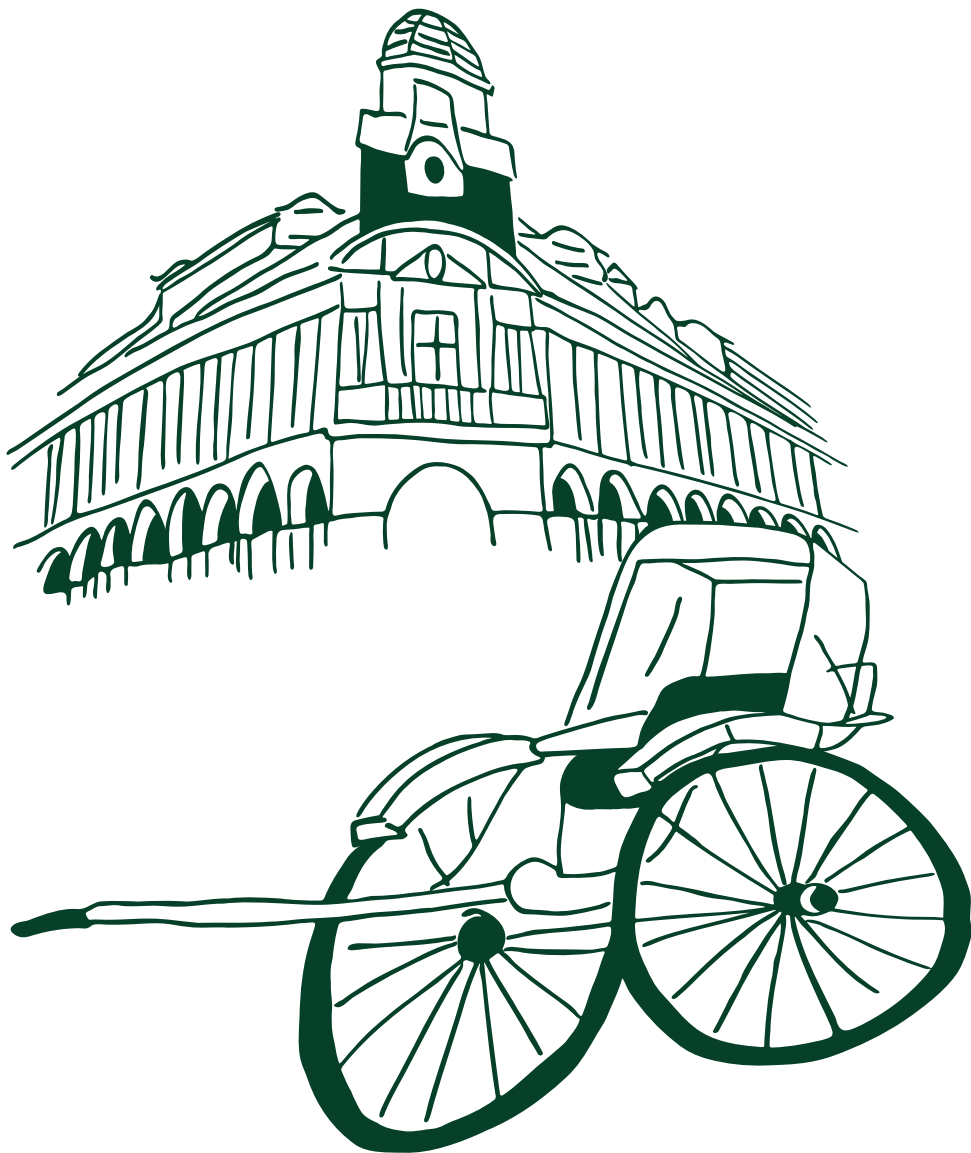
POPPY DEN | 25

SMOKY • FRUITY • BOLD

Smokey Ardbeg 10 single malt whisky, ginger, watermelon, lemon and rose. Bold and sweet-sour, a tribute to Duxton's opium-laced past.

LATE 1800s: RICKSHAW PULLERS & STREET LIFE

Imported from Shanghai in 1880, rickshaws flourished as the city's main transport. The Jinrikisha Station at the junction of Neil Road and Tanjong Pagar Road was built in 1903 as a central depot. The Japanese word "Jinrikisha" translates to "human-powered vehicle".





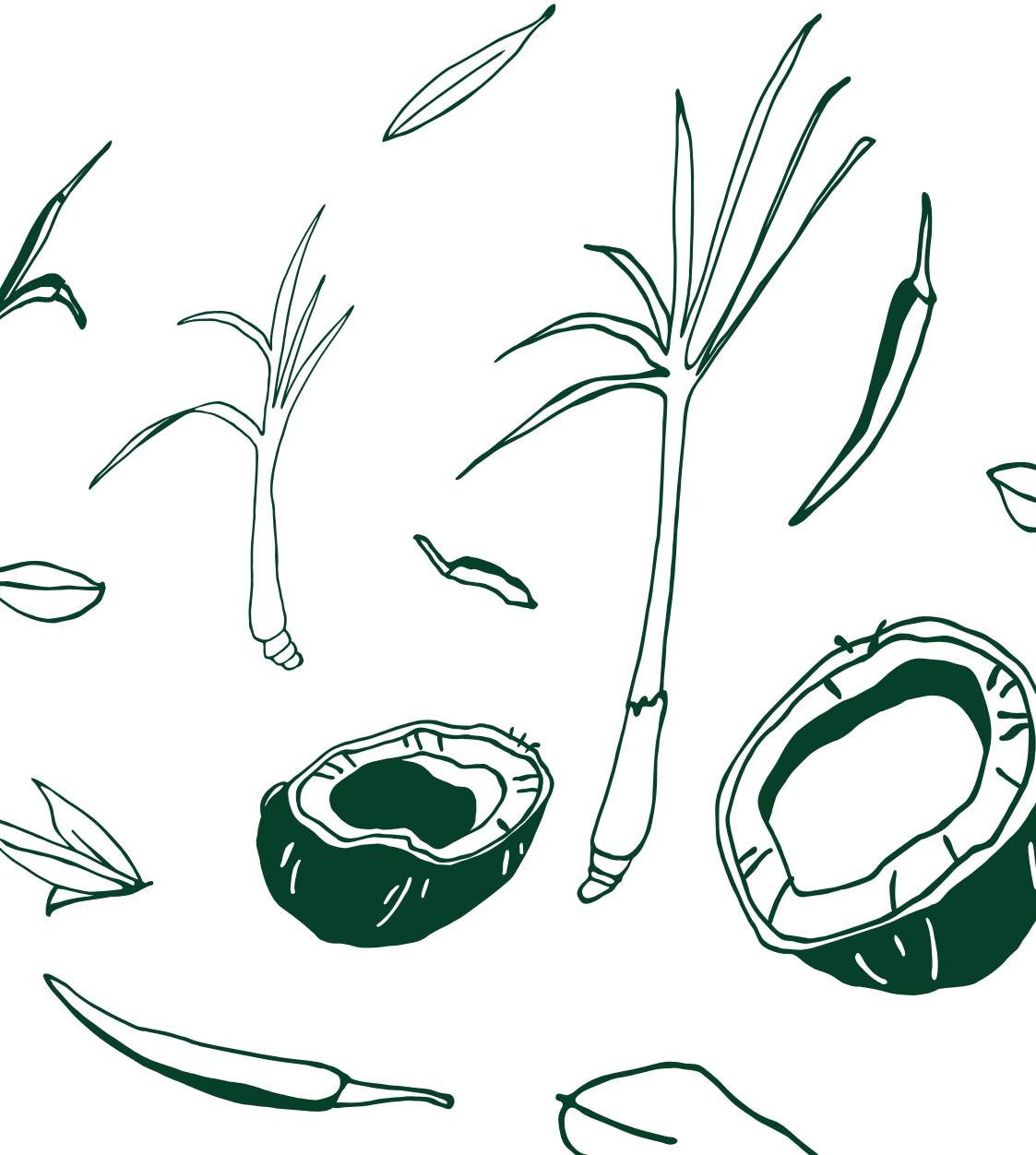
JINRIKISHA | 25

SAVOURY • SWEET & SOUR • UMAMI

Código 1530 Blanco meets the spice of togarashi shrub, tang of pineapple, and nuttiness of sesame. Punchy, invigorating, and layered like the rickshaw runners who once wove through Duxton's streets.

1930s – 1960s: NANYANG CULTURE

The Nanyang art and culture movement fused Chinese traditions with Southeast Asian influence, shaping early Singaporean culture and tastes — its spirit still echoing in Duxton's creative fabric.

NANYANG | 26

BOLD • FRAGRANT • CLEAN

Coconut oil-washed Código 1530 Blanco layered with ancho chile heat, aromatised wine, laksa leaf and lemongrass. The heart of Nanyang spirit, where Chinese heritage meets Southeast Asian spice and soul.

1980s – 1990s: CRAFT & URBAN EDGE

Duxton's revival in the mid-1980s saw heritage shophouses preserved, with new layers of art and design entering the neighbourhood. Today, places like Huls Gallery — housed in a traditional shophouse — highlight Japanese fine craft, mirroring the area's blend of heritage and cosmopolitan edge.





HULS | 25

SAVOURY • FRUITY • SALTY • COMPLEX

Milk-washed Woodford Reserve rye whiskey with white miso, yuzu, and white cacao. Inspired by the nearby Huls Gallery showcasing Japanese fine craft in a heritage shophouse, a familiar sight in Duxton.

1990s – 2000s: DUXTON PLAIN PARK RENEWAL

Further urban renewal of Duxton saw housing redevelopment initiatives and the rejuvenation of Duxton Plain Park, a serene green space contrasting the bustle of city life. In 2023, two sculptural forms by artist Aki Hassan situated in the Northern and Southern points of the park were introduced — **Grounding Points: Settled + Settling In.**

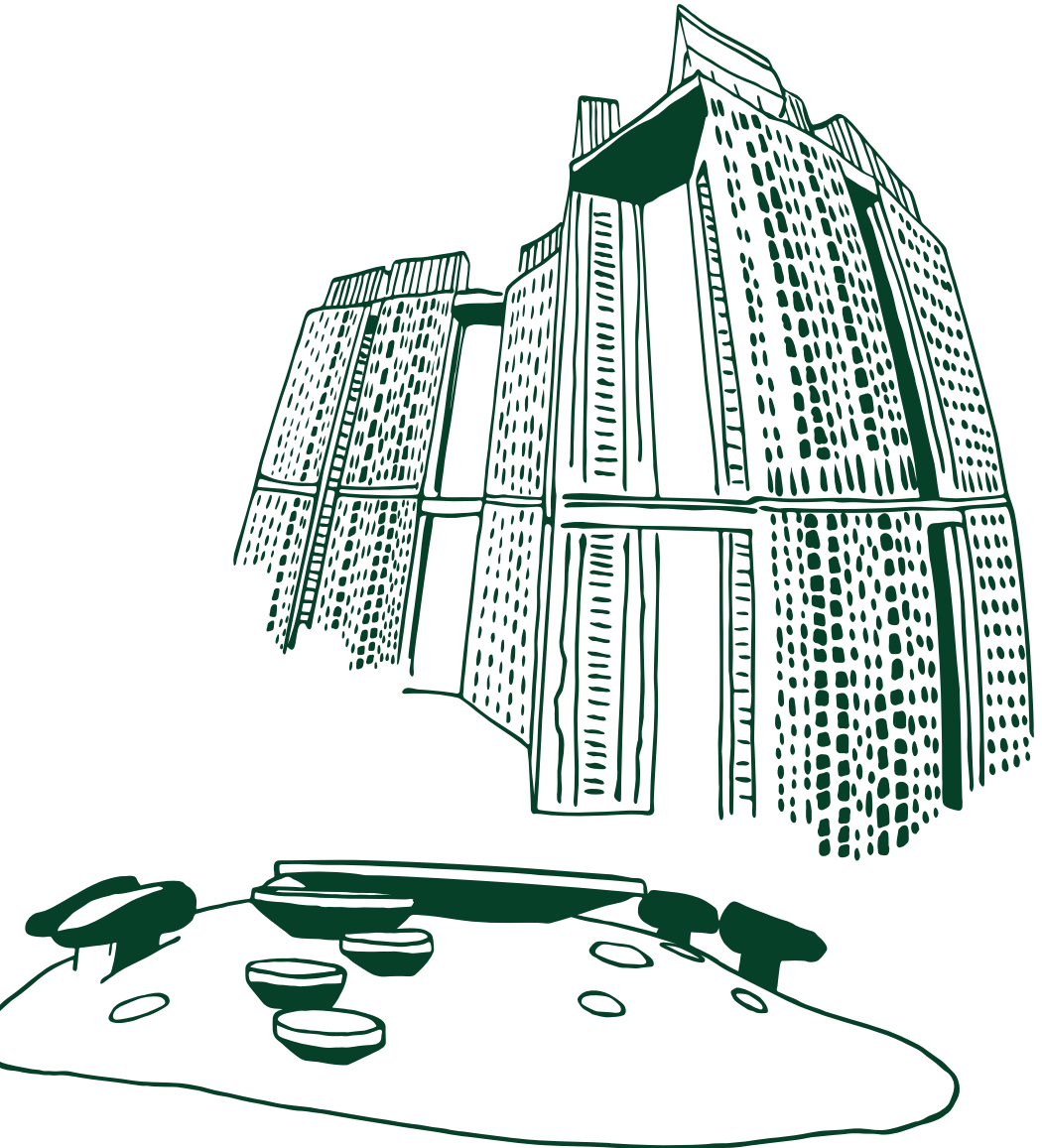

2000s: PINNACLE@DUXTON

The construction of Pinnacle@Duxton marked a significant chapter in the area's history. Completed in 2009, this iconic public housing project is known for its sky bridges that connect seven towers. It stands on the former site of some of Singapore's first HDB public housing blocks, symbolising the city's progress and commitment to high-quality urban living.





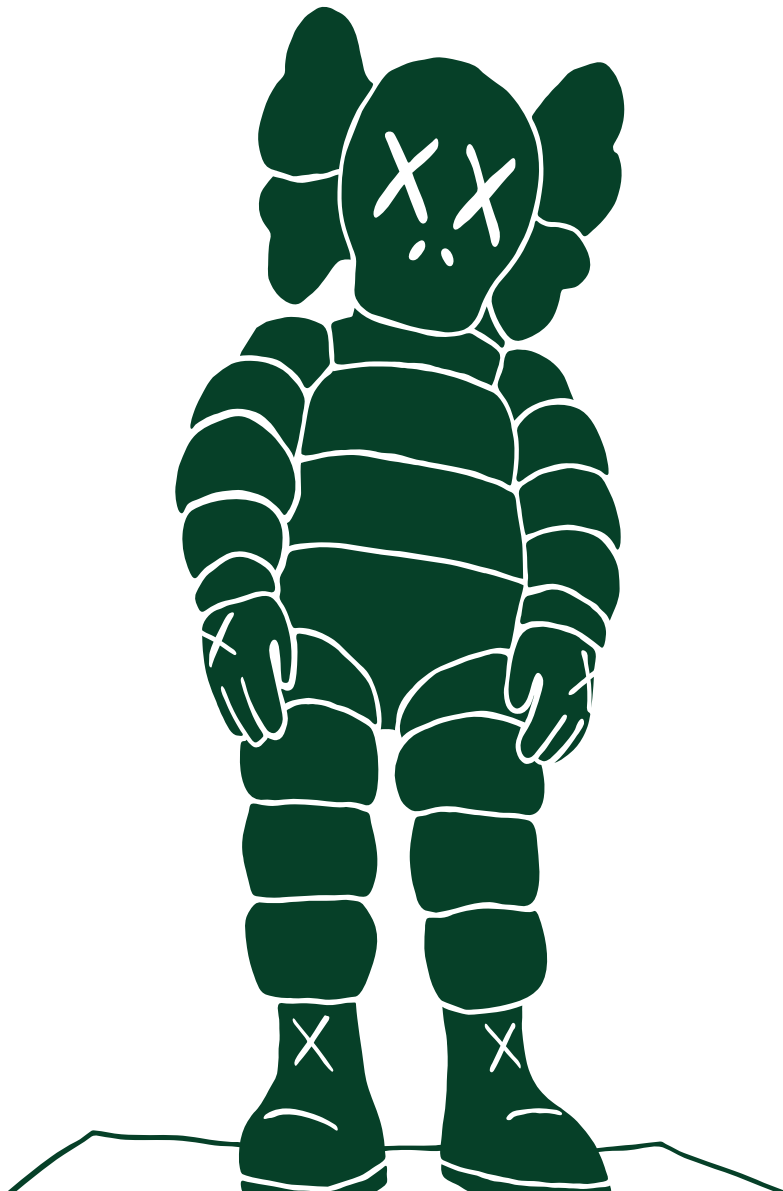
THE PINNACLE | 26

Genmaicha-infused Diplomático Planas rum, Tio Pepe, Lillet, peppermint, and Benedictine D.O.M. A blend grounded in rice, the backbone of Southeast Asia, and a toast to Pinnacle@Duxton — an icon of Singapore's public housing, reimagined with sky bridges and city views.

21ST CENTURY: ART AND MODERN CULTURE

Today, Duxton Hill has evolved into a hub of design, dining, and culture — heritage shophouses now home to restaurants, boutique bars, and creative spaces. A 6-metre bronze WHAT PARTY sculpture by KAWS (Brian Donnelly) anchors this blend of history and contemporary art at Mondrian Singapore Duxton.
